RRSNF Announces that the Joint Information Center is Closing on Saturday, September 30, 2017

SW Oregon—As cooler, wetter weather moves into the area and fire behavior declines, the Joint Information Center plans to close Saturday, September 30 at 5PM.

The Joint Information Center, or JIC, was initially set up to help facilitate the sharing of information with both the media and the public during the peak of the active wildfire season in SW Oregon, and has been active since August 28th. As fire season winds down, that need can be shifted back to both the teams managing the fires and the RRSNF.

Forest spokesperson Chamise Kramer says, “The JIC has been an important component in helping to share a large amount of information, both with the public and with agency folks, at a time when that need was greatest. We at the RRSNF are so grateful to all of our partners who helped to house, set-up and staff this information center. It has made a world of difference!”
